Be a part of 4-H Camp! Get set for a spectacular, fun-filled, 5-day, overnight camp experience!

Fulton County 4-H Camp is held at 4-H Camp Palmer, located in Fulton County, near Fayette. The camp's 146 acres are adjacent to Harrison Lake State Park. 4-H Camp Palmer is privately owned by 4-H members in 11 counties of NW Ohio and has a proud heritage and tradition of wholesome, educational and recreational activities.

Campers 8-13 years old (age as of 1/1/2022) live in cabins near the central area of camp. Each camper has his/her own bunk and area for personal belongings. Each cabin has well-trained camp counselors. We assign youth to cabins in an effort to make it fair to all. During the registration process, you may list ONE friend you would like to be with in a cabin. We will try to honor your request, but this is not a guarantee.

Three meals per day will be served. An evening snack is a tradition at camp, with special treats such as milkshakes supported by the Fulton County Dairy Association.

Adult summer staff members provide special leadership in nature, hiking, indoor and outdoor recreation, athletics, and dance. Swim and canoe programs are under the supervision of qualified lifeguards. Fulton County Extension staff and trained 4-H teen counselors plan and conduct camping programs for 4-H Camp. A registered nurse is on duty during the duration of camp with nearby medical facilities available. 4-H Camp is patrolled by "night walkers" during the night. Parents can volunteer to be a night walker. Contact the OSU Extension office at 419-337-9210 if you are interested in volunteering.

MAJOR SESSIONS, sixty minutes in length will be held each morning. Campers will have the opportunity to experience at their comfort level all of the following six major sessions during their five days at camp.

Line Dancing Make It Your Own Craft

Outdoor Cooking STEM

CHOICE SESSIONS, 30-60 minutes in length will be offered. During this time, campers will be experience activities aligning with their interests. Choice sessions may include: nature hikes, crafts, outdoor games, team building, and more. *Additional fees may apply*.

ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES campers will have the opportunity to experience include:

Indoor Recreation - Recreational dance, games, dramatics, and other activities are offered.

Water Activities - Campers are offered water polo, water sliding, and other water sports. Swimming in the Olympic sized pool will be offered at least daily.

Outdoor Recreation - Activities such as softball, kickball, sand volleyball, tennis, basketball, miniature golf and archery are offered. Camp specific games include: Gaga ball, human foosball and more!

CHALLENGE BY CHOICE ACTIVITIES that campers can opt into for participation include archery, high ropes, climbing wall, or flying squirrel. *Additional fees may apply.*
