

FULTON COUNTY CATTLEFEEDER'S SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY

1. Any Fulton County student involved in 4-H, FFA or FCCLA is eligible.
2. Student must be at least a high school graduate. He or she should be majoring in agriculture, home economics, food technology or veterinary medicine, or if not one of these, an area of study that could relate to agriculture at degree completion.
3. Student must have at least one year remaining before graduation from college.
4. Student must complete the scholarship application and attach a copy of their high school or college grade transcripts.
5. Student must carry a minimum of 2.0 grade point average.

SELECTION

1. Applicant must exhibit evidence of academic ability.
2. Applicant must have demonstrated leadership ability.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

Selection will be made by the scholarship committee of the Cattlefeeder's Association. Applicants may be interviewed by the committee prior to awarding scholarships.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

Minimum of \$500 per school year. Final amount set by the Fulton County Cattlefeeder Board of Directors.

PAYMENT

Total scholarship amounts will be divided equally over the academic year by semester (divided by 2) or quarter (divided by 3). Payment will be made at the end of each quarter or semester upon proof of successful completion of that period.

DEADLINE

Application deadline is May 1st.
