

FULTON COUNTY 4-H CLUB MINI-GRANT APPLICATION

For the current 4-H club year, the Fulton County 4-H Council sub-committee will fund up to 4 mini-grants for clubs, with a maximum of \$50.00 per club.

The mini-grants are meant for the club to carry out an activity that they would not otherwise be able to pursue. Areas suggested by the Endowment Committee include community service that requires supplies, etc., to carry out; recognition (of members, volunteers, alumni, etc.); club educational program speakers/supplies or tours; other ideas that the club members may have.

To be considered, clubs should complete this application and return it to the Extension Office no later than May 1 of the current year. All clubs that apply will be notified as to whether or not they will receive a grant by June 1 of the current year.

Review and selection of the applications will be at the discretion of the Fulton County 4-H Council sub-committee.

A written explanation of the project, poster display or photos of the activity should be prepared and displayed in the fair booth at the Fulton County Fair as follow up for the mini-grant.
