ELIGIBILITY: Applicant must complete eighth grade as of current year and is an active member in Fulton County 4-H. Applicant must have completed two (2) years of 4-H and be currently enrolled in 4-H. Applicants must be enrolled current year in species related project if applicable, preference is for applicant to have completed at least two years of a species related project. *Ex. If applying for Lamb Ambassador you must be enrolled in a sheep project this year.*

APPLICATION: Submit a complete Older Youth Opportunities application (including attached photograph) with the Fulton County 4-H Royalty Additional Application Page to the Fulton County OSU Extension Office by April 1. If an Older Youth Opportunities application has already been submitted this past December (i.e. as a camp counselor), it will be utilized for royalty judging.

SELECTION: Interviews will be held in late May, see the 4-H Handbook for exact interview date. Winners will be selected based upon 30% written test score, 30% written application, and 40% interview. 4-H King and Queen will receive \$250 each, species ambassadors will receive \$200 each. Winners will receive accumulated college/post-secondary educational scholarship(s) upon graduation of high school.

EXPECTATIONS: Royalty are expected to remain in good standing and will complete 4-H projects during their reign. Royalty should wear crowns/sashes/medals at all times and behave as a 4-H representative during community events including festivals, parades, Fulton County Fair, etc. This includes wearing appropriate attire. Royalty are expected to attend the following events:

- Fulton County 4-H camp crowning ceremony
- At least two local community parades
- Respective species Junior Fair shows (if applicable)
- Fulton County Junior Fair Sale (both days if possible)
- Golden Wedding Anniversary Party at the Fulton County Fair
- Additional events specified in your specific congratulatory selection letter (if selected)

Scholarship monies will be allocated upon completion of reign and royalty duties. If a 4-H member receives a scholarship when he or she is not yet enrolled in college or in an alternative post-high school education program, the scholarship will be held until the time he or she is able to produce a tuition or book fee receipt.
