SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Student must live in Fulton County.
- 2. Student must be involved in 4H, FFA or FCCLA.
- 3. Student must be at least a high school graduate with plans to attend college majoring in agriculture, home economics, food technology or veterinary medicine, or if not one of these, an area of study that could relate to agriculture upon degree completion.
- 4. Student must have at least one year remaining before graduation from college.
- 5. Student must complete the attached application.
- 6. Student must provide a copy of his/her high school or college transcript showing that he/she has a minimum grade point average of 2.0.

SELECTION

Applicant should exhibit evidence of academic and leadership ability. Selection will be made by vote of the Fulton County Cattlefeeders Board of Directors. If necessary, applicants may be interviewed by the Directors prior to awarding scholarships.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT/PAYMENT

The amount of the scholarship will be a minimum of \$500 per school year, with the final amount determined by the Fulton County Cattlefeeder Board of Directors. A single payment will be made directly to the student prior to the beginning of the academic year.
